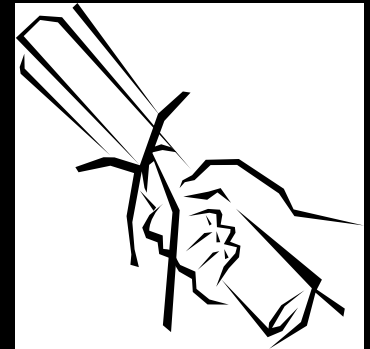

Who should attend?

- Those who are working and cannot attend day classes.
- Anyone who just needs a little prep to be successful at the exam.
- Must have a 10+ on TABE Reading and Math.
- Must be committed to attending each class and completing all assignments.

Follow these steps to your GED:

1st: Attend Orientation to find the educational areas you will need to work on to get your GED. Also, learn about additional options we offer to get you where you want to go.

2nd: Get placed in the **Fast Track** program by a Career Advisor and discuss your personal education plan with your instructor.

3rd: Attend 6 weekly GED classes that assists you with testing skills and strategies.

4th: Take the GED Predictor test that will determine your possible strengths and weaknesses on the GED.

5th: Sign up for the GED after you pass the predictor. Continue honing the skills you need with your GED instructor.

Remember: Your hard work and study habits are what will determine the amount of time it takes to get your GED.

Is this Program for You?

The fast track program is for students **21 and older** with a grade equivalency of 10th grade and above (on the TABE) who have the ability to study *independently*. Students in this program typically do not have the ability to be in a regular GED class due to their work schedule or other obligations.

Getting your GED will depend on your determination and educational level.

What is the GED?

GED stands for General Education Development and is a credential New York State recognizes as an equivalency to the high school diploma. This credential is the key to attending college, getting into the military, and obtaining employment opportunities for those who have not graduated from high school.

Testing Sections

The test has five different sections that every student must pass:

- **Mathematics:** Calculator and Non-Calculator
- **Reading**
- **Social Studies**
- **Science**
- **Writing:** Multiple Choice and Essay
